- 1. Definition of International Students: Anyone with citizenship from a country other than Korea
- \* Korean citizens who hold dual citizenship are NOT eligible to apply as international students.
- \* Students are recognized as international applicants if both they and their parents acquired foreign citizenship before starting an education equivalent to a Korean high school program.
- 2. Only regular elementary, middle, and high school programs recognized under each country's education laws are accepted. Homeschooling, online schooling, the Korean High School Graduate Equivalency Test, and adult or continuing education, whether in Korea or overseas, are not recognized as valid education backgrounds.
- 3. Applicants who are unable to meet our requirements (in terms of the duration of enrollment and/or stay) due to COVID-19 are allowed to submit related documentation (original and notarized copies) to have their eligibility reestablished.
- 4. High school graduate candidates must obtain their diploma by February 28, 2026. However, candidates from countries where high school graduation is later must obtain their diploma by March 31, 2026.



#### \* Note for Korean Language Proficiency

- 1. In case of foreign national applicants who have graduated (or expected graduate) from a regular high school in Korea are exempt from submitting proof of their Korean language proficiency.
- 2. Only certificates of completion from the basic program of the King Sejong Institute are accepted; certificates from the online King Sejong Institute are not recognized.
- 3. Mandatory submission of a TOPIK Level 3 or higher score report within one year of enrollment is required for applicants who fall under any of the categories below:
- ① Those exempt from submitting proof of Korean language proficiency due to graduation (or expected graduation) from a regular high school in Korea
- 2 Those who have completed the Korea Immigration & Integration Program (KIIP)

- 3. Accepted foreign national students are to submit a bank statement that shows a minimum account balance of 20,000,000 KRW or higher for one month or longer. Admission may be revoked if financial documents are not submitted.
- 4. Any record of academic transfer and related transcripts must be submitted.
- 5. A certificate of family relations shall have information on both the applicant and his or her parents.

Your admission or enrollment will be canceled if such misconduct (including plagiarism) is discovered after admission or enrollment or if you fail to meet eligibility requirements (high school graduation, etc.)

- \*What is the restriction on multiple applications?

  Applicants who have been admitted through early admission cannot apply to other admission periods conducted by universities (including colleges of education and industrial universities).

#### B. Other Important Information

- ① SeoulArts does not disclose any information and materials related to admissions and assessment including individual scores.
- ② SeoulArts may choose not to accept applicants whose performance in the assessment was far below the school's standards, even if it fails to recruit the number of students as announced.

#### Apostille Authentication & Consular Legalization

1. Information on the Authentication and Legalization of Academic Credential Documents Issued Overseas

<u>Documentation of academic credentials (transcript and graduation certificate for primary and secondary schools overseas)</u> should be in one of the three forms listed below and submitted before the application deadline.

- A. postille authenticated documents (primary and secondary school transcripts and diplomas)
- B. Consular legalized documents (primary and secondary school transcripts and diplomas legalized either by a Korean Consul in the country of the applicant's citizenship or by a Consul to Korea from the country of the applicant's citizenship)
- C. Transcripts and certificates issued by the China Academic Degrees and Graduate Education Information (www.cdgdc.edu.cn)

  (Applicable only to applicants who have obtained a diploma or degree in China)

#### 2. Apostille Convention

The Apostille Convention is a multilateral agreement that allows the authentication of the origin and validity(legalization) of a public document issued by a country that is a member of the Convention.


